



Update your Microsoft Runtime

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Recently, Microsoft released a patch for the runtime libraries used by VisualStudio 2005, one of the many environments we use for our programs.

Unfortunately, once the patch arrives on our computers (and we like to keep our computers up to date with all Windows® Update patches) all programs compiled will require the new Microsoft runtime. If you don't keep your computer up to date because it is somewhere on a boat or you just don't like bothering with all those updates, the new patches you download from our customer support site might not work on your machine.

Standard HYPACK® 2011 installation is not affected because the Microsoft update came after the release, but everything dated after April 12, 2011 might be affected.
