



# HYPACK® Updates

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One thing I've learned over the years at HYPACK is that our software package is a "living being", forever changing and growing to support new and changing technologies and to meet the needs of our users.

Even though the HYPACK® 2012 release is officially less than two months old, I have quite a collection of emails listing changes that have been implemented since the release was finalized. Some updates include features added after the code was frozen for HYPACK® 2012 beta testing back in November. Others provide bug fixes for errors found after the release.

(No matter how much pre-release testing we do, we never catch everything and a few bugs always seem to turn up!)

Obviously, it's important to keep your install up-to-date, at least with the bug fixes, for optimal performance of your software. Updates other than bug fixes may or may not be of interest to you, depending on the kind of work you do and which modules you use.

## 2012 INTERDEPENDENT FILES

The current list includes a "2012 Interdependent Files" download. It includes the HYPACK® shell and HYLOT along with three files that support some of the changes made in these two executables.

**To avoid file mismatch errors**, extract all five files from the downloaded ZIP file and place them together in your HYPACK® install folder. (That is why they are zipped together as one download.)

## BEFORE YOU DOWNLOAD...

**Check the expiration date on your license.** (Select SETTINGS-LICENSE MANAGER.) If your maintenance plan has expired, your dongle will allow you to run *only files available by the expiration date*.

With Internet access, you can quickly and easily renew your Maintenance Plan, if necessary.
