



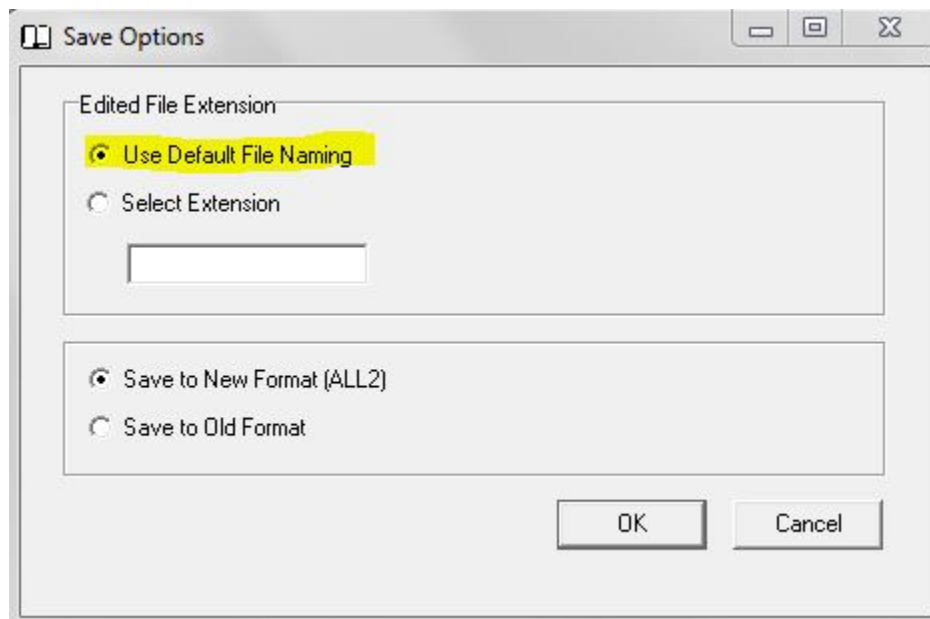
SBMax Update Reverts Back to Previous Naming Convention for Edited Files

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The initial HYPACK® 2012 release included a naming convention change for all edited format files written by the SINGLE BEAM EDITOR (SBMax.exe), when you select “Default File Naming” in the SBMax Save Options. However, due to popular demand, we have reverted back to the naming convention from previous HYPACK® versions.

There is now an SBMAX.exe update - Version 12.0.6.0 (found at <http://www.hypack.com/new/Support/HYPACKProgramUpdates/tabid/152/Default.aspx>) which will give HYPACK® 2012 the same capabilities as previous versions of the SINGLE BEAM EDITOR when selecting “Default File Naming” (Figure 1):

You will need to download the update and unzip the contents of the compressed zipped folder. The SBMax.exe 12.0.6.0 should then be put in your HYPACK® 2012 folder to replace the previous version.

HYPACK® users will still have the ability to save out Edited Format files with a particular extension if the “Select Extension” option is checked in Save Options and the desired extension is entered.
