



2014 Project Manager

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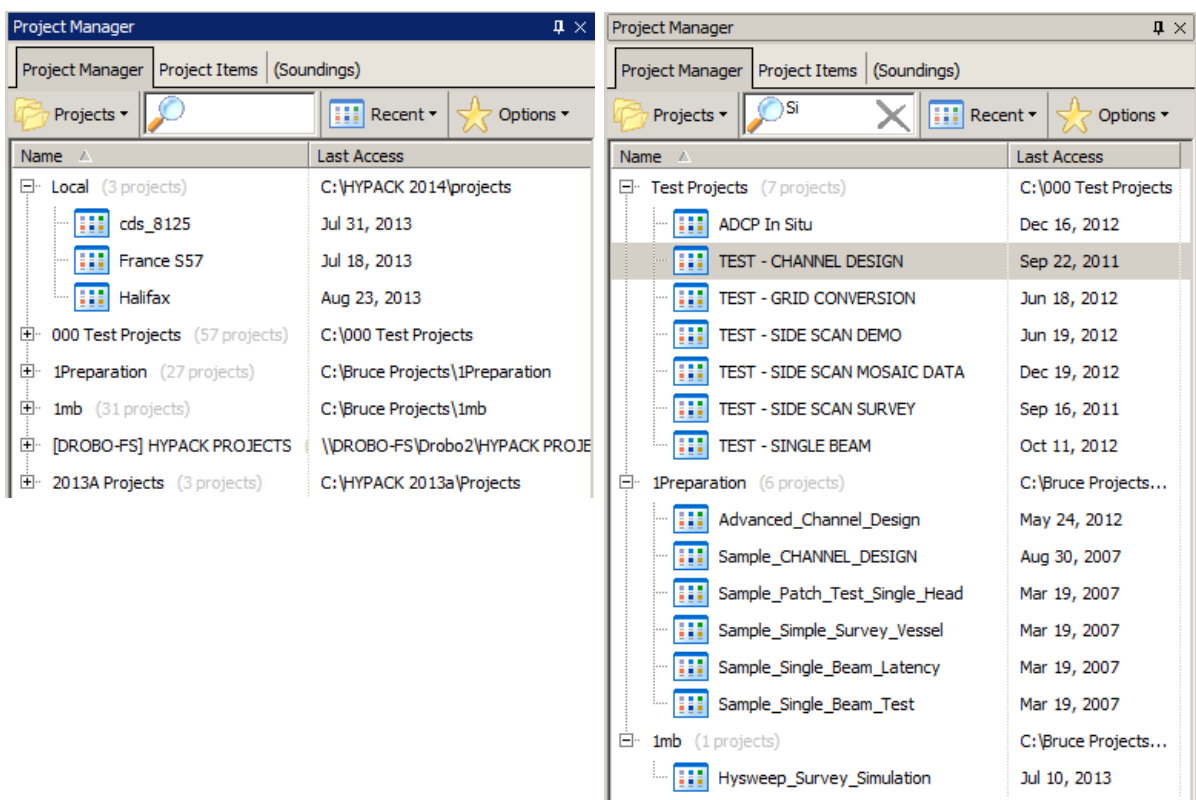
In the 2014 Project Manager, you still have all of the functionality provided in earlier releases (create new, copy, hide, delete...), but there's more!

You can configure the Project Manager to display local projects (\HYPACK 2014\Projects) or the projects at one of your network locations as you did in HYPACK® 2013, or you can display *all of them* at once in a tree view list.

Each folder where you store your projects (a project group) appears in the tree with its project count and path. Each project group expands to display a list of projects it contains and the date it was last accessed.

In addition to viewing all of your project groups at once, you can search the file names in all locations at once. Enter any part of the project name in the search field, and the Project Manager will list only projects whose names include that character sequence, regardless of the file group in which they are stored.

The 2014 Project Manager also includes a new Transfer Project feature which enables you to quickly and easily move a project from one project group to another in about three clicks. Whether it's a local or network project makes no difference. It's much easier and faster than the method provided in earlier versions of HYPACK®.
