



How to Export to Bing Maps

Exporting to Bing maps is very similar to exporting to Google Earth.

1. In the HYPACK® shell, select the files you want to export.

Important: Be aware that Bing Maps limits you to 200 items and *each sounding is an item*.

2. Right-click on a file and select Export to Google Earth.

3. Verify the files and click export. This will let you save to a KMZ file.
4. Open Internet Explorer or Firefox. (As best I can tell, 'Import' isn't supported for Chrome and I'm unable to test Safari.)
5. Go to www.bing.com/maps.
6. Click the "My Places" link on the left. That opens the My Places editor.
7. Click the Import button at the top of the editor to access the Import window.
8. In the Import window, select your KMZ file. When done everything should load up to a My Places group.

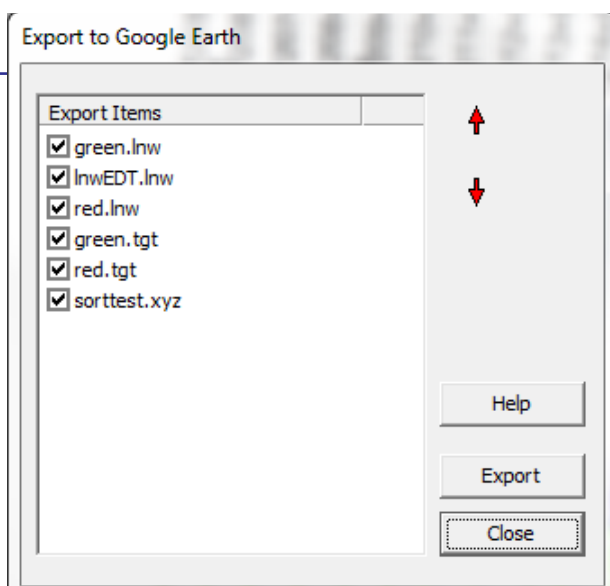


FIGURE 2. My Loaded KMZ Data
