



Russian Interface of HYPACK® on English WINDOWS®

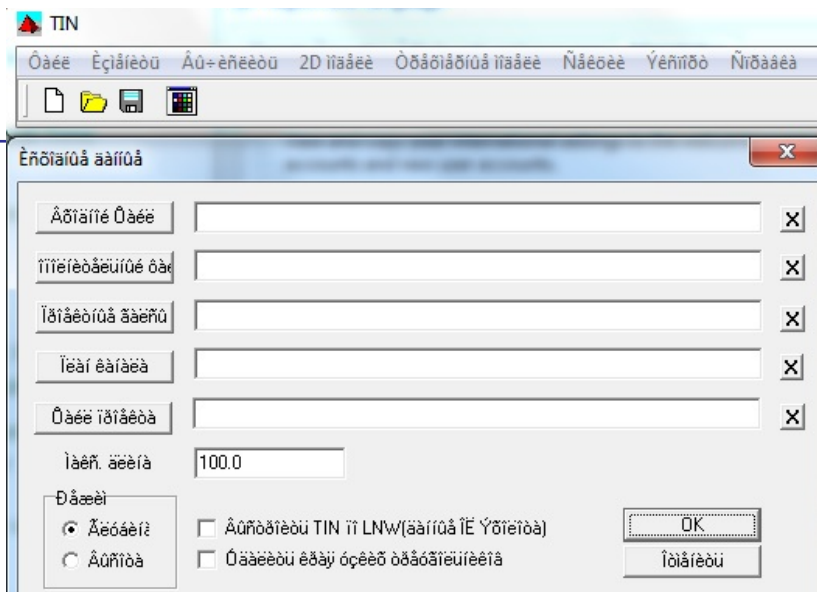
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I've recently discovered a problem on the English Windows® systems while trying to switch to a Russian Interface in the HYPACK® Main Shell as in Figure 1:

FIGURE 1. Russian Characters Displayed Incorrectly with English Language Windows® Setting

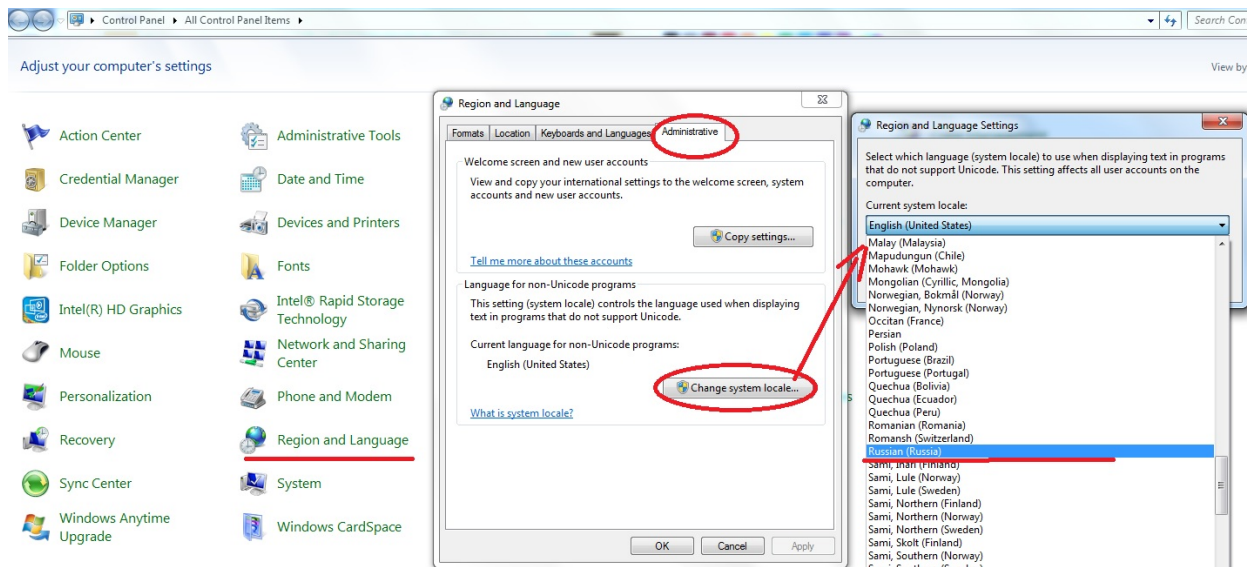
As you can see, in some programs there are unreadable characters.

The root of the problem lies in the fact that some of HYPACK® programs are written in a non-Unicode language. On a Russian WINDOWS® system, it is not a problem since the system already knows about non-Unicode programs. This can be solved quite easy:



1. **Open the Region and Language Settings window.**
 - a. **Select CONTROL PANEL–REGION AND LANGUAGE SETTINGS.**
 - b. **In the Administrative tab, click [Change System Locale].**
2. **Select the Russian language** in the Current System Control drop-down list as shown in Figure 2.

3. **Restart your computer** to apply the changes.

Voila! Now we can read all Russian interface items inside HYPACK®!
