



HYPACK® 2015 Unicode Supports Foreign Characters in Project and File Names

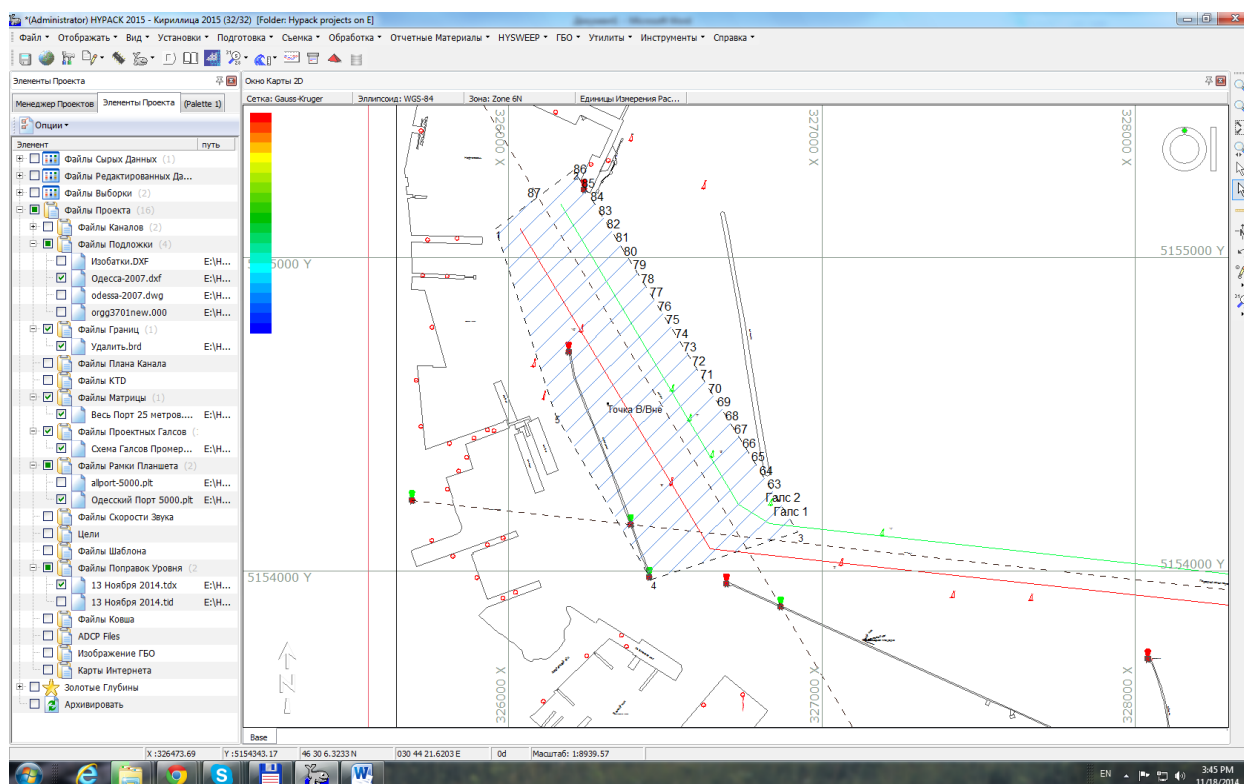
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For a long time, we have advised our users not to use other than Latin characters when you name your project, files and so on in HYPACK®. Well, it is time for a change!

The 2015 release of HYPACK® now supports non-Latin characters in the project and file names. It required a lot of work on the Unicode for our programmers to make the change, but now you may name your project using your own language.

You may name items in your project in your language as well: devices and mobiles in HARDWARE, individual planned lines as well as the LNW file names, BRD files, DXF files and any other project files. And all files and settings work fine in SURVEY.

In the SURVEY program you may now successfully assign your local characters as a file name prefix. The resulting RAW files will load fine in SBMAX (SINGLE BEAM EDITOR) and processed without any errors.

For Russian speaking customers, the HYPACK® Interface has also been updated and some menu items now correctly translated.

Finally, the HYPACK® Manual in Russian is underway and will be probably available sometimes next winter.
