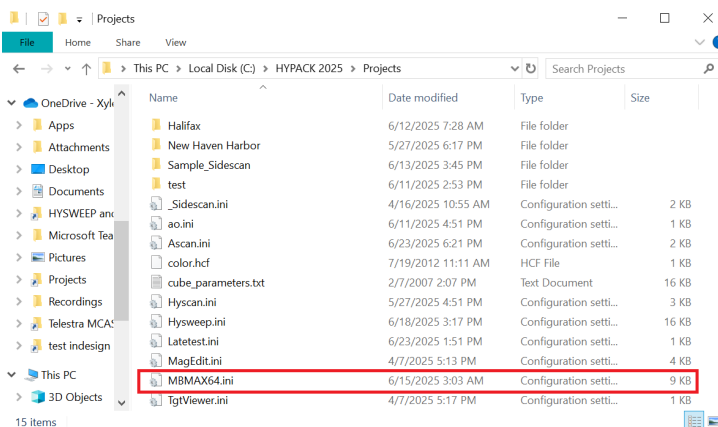


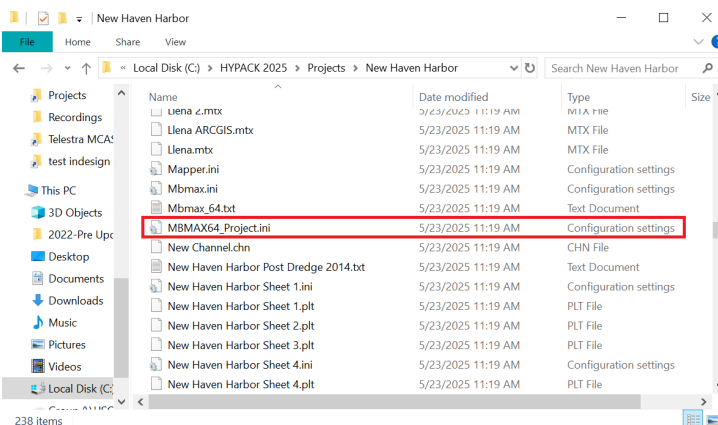
Help: Missing Windows in the HYSWEEP® Editor (MBMAX64)

Sometimes, while running the HYSWEEP® Editor (MBMAX64), if you click and load windows or dialog boxes from MBMAX64, they do not appear on your screen. This mostly occurs if you had the window displayed on a separate monitor during your previous editing session. Even worse, you might not see the main MBMAX64 window at all! Should you uninstall HYPACK® to try to cure this issue? Of course not! Here is what you need to do.



MBMAX64.ini – This initialization file stores all MBMAX64 window and option settings, excluding the Read Parameters. Locate MBMAX64.ini in the C:\HYPACK 202x\Projects folder, where x is the last digit of HYPACK® version installed on your computer. Delete this *.ini file to reset MBMAX64 to the default state. Now, if you open MBMAX64, all windows will return to their default locations.



MBMAX64_Project.ini – This file, located in a project's folder (in this example, C:\HYPACK 2025\Projects\New Haven Harbor), stores all Read Parameters specific to this project. Although I haven't encountered anyone who had trouble displaying their HYSWEEP® data, it is worth knowing where all Read Parameters settings are stored. Again, if your data looks abnormal or completely unexpected, it may be due to incorrect Read Parameters. Always double check these parameters when loading your data, even if you previously made edits. You never know – your coworker might have worked on this project after you and changed the Read Parameters.
