Controlling water levels is *always* critical, but particularly so during storm events.

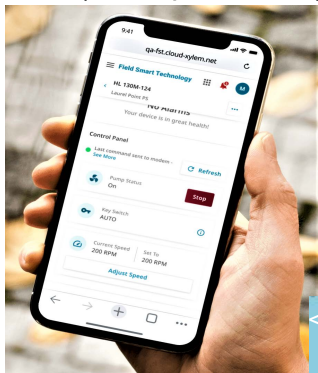
